Notification

The 4th August, 1972

No. G.S.R. 187/Const/Art.309/72.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following amendment in the Haryana Government, General Administration Department, General Services, notification No. 523-3GS-70/2068, dated the 28th January, 1970, namely :—

AMENDMENT

1. In the said notification, for clauses (3) and (4) of para 2, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

“(3) If the Chairman or a member at the time of his appointment as such is a retired Government employee, either his pension including pension equivalent to other forms of retirement benefits will be held in abeyance or his remuneration will be reduced to the extent of gross amount of his pension including the pension equivalent to other forms of retirement benefits.

(4) If a Government employee appointed as Chairman or member retires from the service to which he belongs during the course of his tenure as Chairman or member as the case may be, either his pension including pension equivalent to other forms of retirement benefits will be held in abeyance or his remuneration will be reduced to the extent of gross amount of his pension including pension equivalent to other forms of retirement benefits.”

2. This amendment shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 28th January, 1970.
