1. The Singapore High Commission has offered the above-mentioned workshop to be held in Singapore during 23-25 February, 2010 under the Singapore-World Trade Organisation TCTP.
2. The applicants should be middle to senior level government officials, nominated by their respective Governments and should be below 50 years of age.
3. Under the Singapore-WTO-TCTP arrangement, the Government of Singapore will bear the cost of round-trip airfare of the participants, training allowance, local transport costs, accommodation and hospitalization insurance.
4. Each participant is advised to have money for miscellaneous expenses that might be incurred prior to receiving the allowance.
5. The number of nominations to be sent to this Department may not exceed One with one reserve.
6. The nominations of suitable candidates may be done in accordance with the Department of Economic Affairs' OM No.1/13/03-PMU dated 27.2.2006. The nomination details should be submitted on the following:
 1. Prescribed application form
 2. DEA's prescribed proforma - duly countersigned by competent authority.
7. Last date for submission: The completed 'application form' should reach this Department not later than 30.12.2009. Nominations received after the prescribed date will not be considered.
