TRAINING CIRCULAR

Subject: A Group Training Course in Non-Revenue water Management to be held in Japan from 1st November 2010 to 18th December 2010.

The undersigned is directed to state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), under the Technical Cooperation Programme of the Government of Japan has invited applications for the above programme. The total duration of the programme is from 1st October 2010 to 18th March 2011, out of this the core phase from 1st November 2010 to 18th December 2010 will be held in Japan. The Preliminary Phase and the Finalization Phase will be held in the candidate's home country. The details of the programme and the application form may be drawn from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (persmin.nic.in).

- 2. The Program aims to obtain and upgrade knowledge and skills on non-revenue water management focusing on leakage prevention work, with a goal of availability and supply of safe drinking water in the target countries.
- 3. The Candidate should be a technical official in charge of maintaining and managing waterworks system; have more than 5 years experience in maintaining and managing waterworks system and be middle class administrative officials who are less than forty years of age; be a university graduate in an engineering discipline or the equivalent; be proficient at written and spoken English; be in good health, both physically and mentally to undergo the training and not be serving in the military.
- 4. The fellowship award covers a Round-trip air ticket between an international airport designated by the JICA and Japan; travel insurance from the time of arrival in Japan to departure from Japan; allowances for (accommodation, living expenses, outfit and shipping); expenses for JICA study tours and free medical care for participants who may fall ill after reaching Japan (costs related to pre-existing illness, pregnancy, or dental treatment are not included). The participants are not allowed to take any family member during the training course.
- 5. It is requested that the nomination of the suitable candidates may please be forwarded to this Department in accordance with the eligibility criteria and the terms and conditions of the JICA's Circular dated 8th July 2010. The Ministry/State Governments may sponsor the names of only Government/ Public Sector Undertaking functionary.
- 6. The nomination details should be submitted in the JICA's prescribed proformas (A2A3 Forms) duly authenticated by the Department concerned alongwith the country report.
