

TRAINING CIRCULAR

Subject: Scholarship offer for the following Master's Programme at the KDI School of Public Policy and Management, Republic of Korea, to commence from January 2011 :-

- (i) Master of Public Policy (MPP)
- (ii) Master of Public Policy in Economic Development (MPP.ED)
- (iii) Master of Public Policy in Public Management (MPP/PM)

The undersigned is directed to state that the Embassy of India, Seoul, on behalf of the KDI School, has invited applications for the above Master's Degree Programmes. The details of the programme may be accessed from the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (persmin.nic.in).

2. These programmes are to be conducted by the Korea Development Institute (KDI) School of Public Policy and Management, scheduled to commence from January 2011 and are of duration of 1.5 years consisting of 4 semesters, out of which the coursework will be done in the 1st year at KDI School and the Thesis writing in the 2nd year will be done at the Home Country. The scholarship covers full tuition and additional financial aid to cover the costs on housing, meals and other living expenses.

3. The Master of Public Policy program aims to equip students with a global perspective and an in-depth professional expertise in public policy issue areas. The students may declare a concentration from among Financial Markets and Regulation; Human Resource and Social Policy; International Macroeconomic Policy; International Relations and Political Economy; Public Financial and Local administration; Real Estate and Public Policy and Trade and Industrial Policy.

4. The MPP in Economic Development Program aims to train international professionals such as development consultants and regional specialists, who wish to contribute to the development of the global economy. It is focused on equipping Government officials from the developing world with the needed knowledge and tools to improve the formulation and implementation of development policies in their respective countries. The students may declare a concentration in either Economic Policy or Management for Development

5. The MPP in Public Management Program is an innovative, interdisciplinary program focused on developing the strategic management and leadership skills necessary for public sector organizations. In addition to learning essential management theories and analytic tools students gain insightful perspectives by learning through case study method and develop the practical skills needed to solve real-world problems, resolve conflicts and lead organizations.



6. The candidate should have a Bachelor's degree or equivalent and English proficiency. Government officials are preferred and work experience is recommended.

7. Candidates have to apply online at (www.kdischool.ac.kr) and then mail the requisite documents to the KDI School.

8. It is requested that besides applying online the nomination of the suitable candidates may please be forwarded to this Department in accordance with the eligibility criteria and the terms and conditions of the KDI School's brochure available on this Department's website. The Ministry/ State Governments may sponsor the names of only Government/ Public Sector Undertaking functionary.

9. The applications should reach this Department through the Administrative Ministry/State Governments not later than 21st October 2010. Nominations received after the prescribed date will not be considered. The circular inviting applications for training courses is available on this Department's website persmin.nic.in
