## TRAINING CIRCULAR

Subject: A Group Training Course in Construction Technology Introduced and/or Applied to Developing Countries to be held in Japan from 8th May 2011 to 25th June 2011.

The undersigned is directed to state that the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), under the Technical Cooperation Programme of the Government of Japan has invited applications for the above programme, to be held in Japan from 8th May 2011 to 25th June 2011. The details of the programme and the application form may be drawn from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (persmin.nic.in).

- 2. The Program aims to contribute to improve the civil engineering in their respective countries and motivate the participants to work on the establishment of their own technical standard and system.
