Dear Chief Secretary,

As you are aware, IAS Officers of 2013, 2014 and 2015 Batches were posted as Assistant Secretaries in various Ministries/Departments of Government of India for a period of three months after their Phase II training at LBSNAA, Mussoorie.

2. While addressing at Valedictory Session for IAS Officers of 2015 Batch on 26.09.2017, the Hon'ble Prime Minister emphasized on maintaining a structured mechanism to keep in touch with Assistant Secretaries of the 3 batches i.e. 2013, 2014 & 2015. Accordingly, all Ministries of Government of India are being advised to take action.

3. The Prime Minister also encouraged the Assistant Secretaries (IAS Officers 2015 Batch (DR)) to focus on the following:

- (i) GST – with a view to simplify/solve issues in implementation.
- (ii) Digital transaction/BHIM – push towards less-cash economy.
- (iii) GeM – increase the outreach of e-procurement using the GeM platform. If there are any issues in implementation, Assistant Secretaries may bring it to the notice of Government of India/Cabinet Secretariat.
- (iv) SOWBHAGYA – ensure availability of electricity to every household in every village in their respective sub-divisions.
- (v) The Chandigarh and Puducherry have done exemplary work in DBT. The Assistant Secretaries may study this and replicate in their respective sub-divisions.
- (vi) Apart from official work, Assistant Secretaries may visit a School or College once in a month, to share their success stories and motivate students, especially of the 10th to 12th standard.
