I am directed to invite your attention towards Govt. instructions No. 18/02/2017-2GSI, dated 22.02.2017 on the subject noted above and to say that it was laid down in these instructions that a person while entering the Govt. job should give an undertaking in writing that if and when he enters any marital alliance, he shall strictly comply with anti-dowry law in letter and spirit and also furnish full details of all the articles of property and amounts of money received by him from his in-laws in any name or manner, whatsoever.

The matter has been further considered and it has been decided that every serving employee will submit the undertaking as prescribed in rule 18(2) of Haryana Civil Services (Govt. Employees' Conduct) Rules, 2016 and concerned department should upload the same in HRMS through their controlling office, Treasury Officers/HOD.
