It is also requested to follow the preventive measures such as maintaining social distancing, wearing of masks etc. as prescribed and recommended by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, while organizing the appropriate programme for the occasion.

In addition, considering importance and solemnity of the occasion, innovative ways of propagating and message of anti-terrorism through digital and social media platforms, may also be considered.

You are also requested that a report on the actual observance of the "Anti Terrorism Day" in the district may be sent to the State Government in due course.
