Sir.

With reference to this Ministry's vacancy circular of even number dated 26.03.2019, I am directed to say that it is proposed to fill up, in consultation with UPSC, two (02) posts of Director and seven (07) posts of Deputy Secretary (Non-CSS posts) in the CIS Division of Ministry of Home Affairs on Deputation basis. The particulars of the post, eligibility conditions etc. are given in Annexure-1.

The pay of the selected officer will be regulated in accordance with the Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/8/2009-Estt. (Pay II) dated 17.06.2010 as amended from time to time.

3. The maximum age limit for appointment on deputation (including short-term contract) shall be 56 years. Accordingly, the persons who will be crossing the age of 56 years, on the last date of receiving of applications as indicated in para-5 need not apply.

Officers who volunteer for the post will not be permitted to withdraw their names later. Only such recommendations as are accompanied by the requisite personal data as in Annexure-II will be considered.
