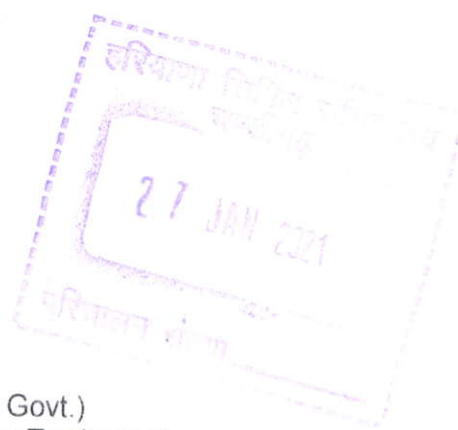

Filling up two (02) post of Architect on deputation in the pay scale of 15600-39100+7600/- Grade Pay in the Architecture Wing, Department of Urban Planning, Chandigarh Administration.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to address you on the subject matter and to state that two (02) posts of **Architect** in the pay scale of Rs. 15600-39100+7600/- G.P in the Architecture Wing of the Department of Urban Planning, Chandigarh Administration is to be filled up by deputation in consultation with UPSC from Central/State Govts/Union Territories. The officers who are not more than 56 years of age can apply for the posts as per the details given below:-

3.	Classification	General Central Service Group 'A' Gazetted Non-ministerial.
4.	Pay-Scale	Rs.15600-39100+7600 Grade Pay (as per Punjab 5 th Pay Commission adopted by Chandigarh Administration)
5.	Method of Recruitment and details.	60% by promotion failing which by deputation. 40% by deputation failing which by direct. Deputation is to be made from the Officers of the Central/State Governments/Union Territories- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/Department; or (ii) with 7 years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Central Govt. Pay scale of Rs.8000-13500 (unrevised) / Rs.15600-39100 + 5400 Grade Pay (Revised) or equivalent in the parent cadre/Department; and (b) Possessing the following educational and other qualifications:- (i) Degree in Architecture of a recognised University or equivalent (ii) should be registered as Architect with Council of Architecture, India (iii) five years experience in the profession. Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified. Note 2: The Qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes or Scheduled Tribes. If at any stage of selection the UPSC is of the opinion that sufficient no. of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them. (The Departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.

		Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
Other Terms and Conditions		
1.	Period of Deputation	One year in the first instance and to be extended from time to time or reduced according to requirement.
2.	Pay	He/she will draw pay in his/her own scale of pay without any deputation allowance.
3.	DA, Local Allowances	According to the Punjab Rules so long the employees of Chd. Admn. are also governed by these rules.
4.	T.A. Joining time and transfer T.A.	According to the rules of Govt. to which deputed i.e. Chandigarh Administration.
5.	Leave and Pension	The rules of the Parent Govt.
6.	Leave Travel concession Medical concession and accommodation	According to parent Deptt.
7.	Leave Salary and pension contribution	The allocation of leave salary and pension charges payable by this Administration will be regulated under the rules of the parent Govt.

The eligible officers should apply for the aforesaid posts and also forward their applications through their department. While forwarding the applications of the eligible officers, the concerned department should furnish the following document and certificates:-

- (ii) Attested copies (on each page of ACRs/APAR) for the last five years.
- (iii) Cadre clearance, Integrity Certificate, Vigilance Clearance Certificate and statement of major/minor penalties if any, imposed on the candidate during the last 10 years, in original or no penalty certificate, as the case may be forwarded duly signed & stamped by the Competent Authority.
- (iv) Certificate regarding no court case is pending against the officer concerned.

Officer who apply for the post will not be allowed to withdraw their candidature at a later stage. Application not received through proper channel or after the due date or without the above mentioned documents will be rejected.

The suitable and willing officers must apply through proper channel within 60 (Sixty) days of the Publications of this advertisement in the 'Employment News'.
