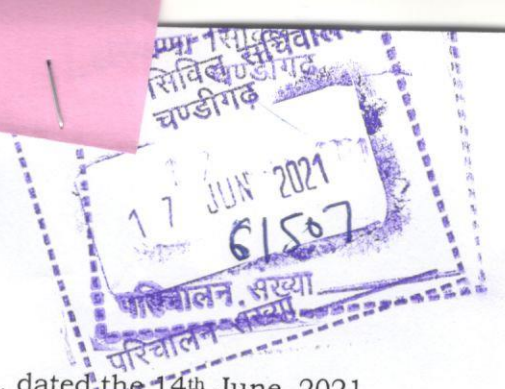

**Subject:** Selection for the posts of Technical Member, National Anti-Profitteering Authority (NAA)-reg.

Sir/Madam

Section 171 of the Central Goods & Services Act 2017, provides that any reduction in rate of tax on any supply of goods or services or the benefit of input tax credit shall be passed on by the supplier to the recipient (of such goods or services) by way of commensurate reduction in prices. Further, the Central Government may, on recommendation of the GST Council, by notification, constitute an Authority to examine whether the reduction in the rate of tax or the benefit of input tax credit has actually resulted in a commensurate reduction in the price of goods or services or both supplied by him.

2. As per Rule 122 of Central Goods & Services Tax Rules 2017, National Anti-Profitteering Authority (NAA) shall consist of a Chairman who holds or has held a post equivalent in rank to a Secretary to the Government of India; and four Technical Members who are or have been Commissioners of State Tax or Central Tax for at least one year or have held an equivalent post under the existing law, to be nominated by the GST Council. Further, in terms of Rule 124(5) of the Central Goods & Services Tax Rules 2017, no person shall be selected as a Technical Member of the Authority if he has attained the age of 62 years; provided further that the Central Government with the approval of the Chairperson of the Council may terminate the appointment of the Technical Member at any time. The names of Chairman and four Technical Members of NAA will be recommended by a Selection Committee constituted under Rule 124(1) of the said Rules. As on date, there are two vacancies of Technical Member, NAA.

3. Since no application has been received in response to the Department of Revenue's earlier letter of even no. dated-06.04.2021, it is once again requested to forward names of eligible officers for appointment as Technical Member, NAA against two vacancies and send the details of eligible officers in the proforma enclosed (Annexure-I) by 30.06.2021.
