



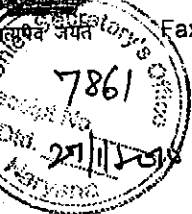

Dear Chief Secretary,

As you are aware the Unique Identification of India has been set up as an attached office under the Planning Commission and has been entrusted with the ambitious task of providing a Unique Identification to each citizen of the country. The UIDAI has set up its Headquarter in Delhi and has 8 Regional Centres in Delhi, Bangalore, Hyderabad, Mumbai, Ranchi, Guwahati, Lucknow and Chandigarh.

- Several posts at various levels have been created in the Authority which need to be filled up urgently so that the work of the Authority can commence. Each of the Regional Offices is headed by a DDG, an officer of Joint Secretary rank. There are 4 posts of ADGs in each of the Regional Offices which are at DS/Director rank.
