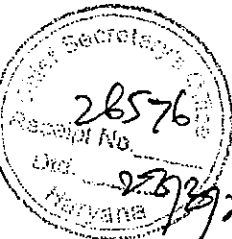
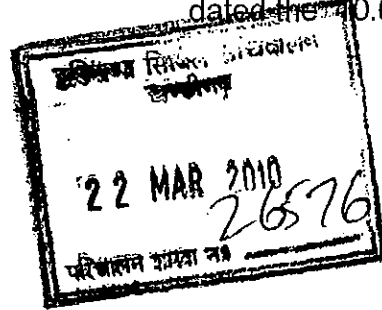
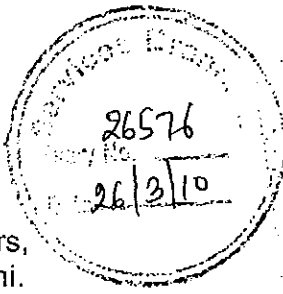

Sir/Madam,

In continuation to this Department circular of even No. dated 08.02.2010, it is proposed to fill up the post of Director [R&D], under the Department of Atomic Energy, Mumbai.

2. Officers of the rank of Deputy Secretary/Director of the Government of India or equivalent level, eligible for appointment under the Central Staffing Scheme are eligible for the post. The period of deputation is 4/5 years for the Dy. Secretary/Director.
3. The vacancy may be circulated among willing and eligible officers of the IAS of Deputy Secretary/Director level on priority basis. Names of willing and eligible officers who can be spared by the State Governments/Ministries/Departments may be forwarded to this Department along with **cadre clearance, vigilance clearance**. It may be ensured that the 'Cooling off', after a previous stint on deputation, if any, is completed and the officers is eligible to be appointed on Central Deputation as per rules.
