



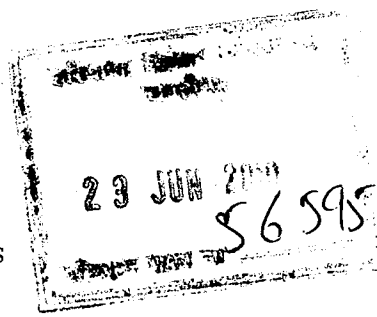

CIRCULAR

The Ministry of External Affairs (CPV Division) intends to fill up the post of Deputy Passport Officer in the Passport Office, Jalandhar in the pre-revised scale of Rs.10,000 – 325 - 15,200/- (revised Pay Band of Rs. 15,600 - 39,100 + Grade Pay Rs. 6,600/-) from amongst officers of CSS / All India Services in the Ministries/Departments of the Government of India on deputation basis. As per the existing recruitment rules for the post, an officer holding analogous post on regular basis or holding a post with 5 years regular service in the pre-revised scale of Rs. 8,000 – 275 – 13,500/- (revised Pay Band Rs. 15,600-39,100 + Grade Pay Rs.5,400/-), is eligible for holding the post on deputation basis.

The selected officer will be designated as Acting Passport Officer, Jalandhar and will be the Head of Office. The officer will be on deputation for a period of two years initially which may be curtailed or extended further depending on the requirements with the consent of the officer and with the approval of the lending Department. The usual deputation terms will apply.

All Ministries/Departments of Government of India are requested to circulate the post among the officers of CSS / All India Services working with them and forward the application of eligible and interested officers, along with their CR dossiers and a certificate to the effect that they are clear from vigilance angle, to the undersigned latest by 9th July, 2010.
