



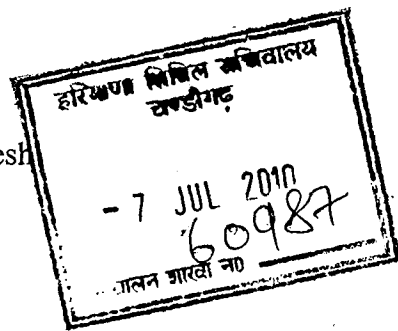

Sub: Appointment of Chairman, Arunachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission – invitation of proposals and nominations thereof.

Sir,

The Government of Arunachal Pradesh has established the Arunachal Pradesh State Electricity Regulatory Commission under the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003. The Commission shall consist of one member to be known as Chairman of the Arunachal Pradesh State Electricity Regulatory Commission with Headquarter at Itanagar. The post need to be filled up at the earliest. A selection committee has already been constituted for the purpose.

2 I am directed to invite proposals and nominations of candidates for consideration of the Selection Committee for the post of the Chairman of the Arunachal Pradesh State Electricity Regulatory Commission. The nominees should be persons of ability, integrity and standing having adequate knowledge and experience of, and shown capacity in dealing with problems relating to engineering, finance, commerce, law or management.

3 The terms of appointment will be in general accordance with provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and including the following:

1. The persons appointed would have to resign or opt for voluntary retirement from the service to which he/she belongs;
2. The Chairman would hold the office for a term of five years or till attainment of age of 65 years whichever is earlier from the date he/she



enters in his/her office, but shall not be eligible for re-appointment in the same capacity in the Commission;

3. In case of ceasing to hold office as Chairman, shall –

- a. not accept any commercial employment for a period of two years from the date he ceases to hold office;
- b. not represent any person before the Central Commission or any other State Commission in any manner.

4 The Chairman shall receive a pay in the Pay Band HAG + Scale (Rs.75,000-80,000/-)pm with other allowances as admissible to the post in the State belonging to All India Services Cadre and others terms and conditions shall be as prescribed in the Arunachal Pradesh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairman) Rules, 2010 (a copy enclosed).

5 The nominations should contain the followings –

1. Bio-data of proposed candidate containing the following details –

- a. Name
- b. Age & Date of Birth
- c. Position presently held
- d. Educational qualification
- e. Details of post previously held and experience in the relevant field

2. Willingness letter to resign his/her present post to join the Arunachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission, if selected.

3. A letter from the proposed nominee intimating the details of any office, employment of Consultancy agreement or arrangement which he/she has in his/her own name or in any firm, association of persons or body corporate, or in the names of any relative carrying on any of the following business, namely –

- a. generation, transmission, distribution or supply of electricity;
- b. manufacture, sale or supply of any fuel for generation of electricity


- c. manufacture, sale, lease, hire or otherwise, supply of or dealing in machinery, plant, equipment, apparatus or fittings for generation, transmission, distribution, supply or use of electricity; and
- d. any entity providing professional services to any of the businesses referred to sub-clauses (a), (b) and (c) above.

6 The nominations as indicated above are to be sent to the Secretary (Power), Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Jal Vidyut Bhawan, Itanagar – 791 111. The nominations may be submitted within 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 from the date of issue of this letter for further scrutiny and proper examination.

7 The proposals/nominations received in response to this letter will be placed before the Selection Committee.

## NOTIFICATION

The 19th May, 2010

PWRS/W-1075/2004.— In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 180 read with section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Act No. 36 of 2003), the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh do hereby make the following rules prescribing the conditions of service of the Chairman of the Arunachal Pradesh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (APSERC) established vide notification No. PWRS/W-1075/2004 dated 7th May, 2010.

1. **Short title and commencement :** (1) These rules may be called the Arunachal Pradesh State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairman) Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Definitions :** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

(a) "Act" means the Electricity Act 2003 and

(b) words and expression used herein and not defined but defined in the Act, shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.

3. **Oath of office and secrecy :** The Chairman shall before entering upon his office, subscribe to an oath of office and secrecy before the Minister in charge of the Ministry of Power. The oath of office and secrecy shall be administered in the form as prescribed in the Schedule (I & II) annexed to this rule :

4. **Pay :** The Chairman shall receive a pay in the pay band HAG + Scale (Rs. 75,000-80,000 p.m.) with other allowances as admissible to the post in the state belonging to All India Services Cadre :

Provided that if the Chairman has been a Judge of the Supreme Court or Chief Justice of a High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the Supreme Court or the Chief Justice of High Court :

Provided further that in case a person appointed as the Chairman is in receipt of any pension, the pay of such person shall be reduced by the gross amount of pension drawn by him :

Provided also that the Chairman shall be entitled to draw allowances on the original basic pay before such fixation of pay.

5. **Dearness allowance and city compensatory allowance :** The Chairman shall receive dearness allowance and city compensatory allowance, and other allowances at the rate admissible to a Group 'A' Officer of the Central/State Government drawing an equivalent pay :

Provided that in case the Chairman is or has been a Judge of the Supreme Court or Chief Justice of a High Court, he shall receive dearness allowance at the rate admissible to a Judge of the Supreme Court or the Chief Justice of a High Court, as the case may be.

6. **Leave :** The Chairman shall be entitled to thirty days earned leave for every year of service. The payment of leave, salary, during leave shall be governed under the provisions of **Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972** as amended upto date.

7. **Leave sanctioning authority :** In the case of the Chairman, the Minister of Power in charge of the Ministry, shall be the leave sanctioning authority.

8. **Provident fund :** The Chairman shall be governed by the provisions of the Contributory Provident Fund Rules 1962.

9. **Traveling allowances :** (1) The Chairman while on tour within India or on transfer (including the journey undertaken by self and family to join the Commission or on the expiry of term with the Commission to proceed to his home town with family) shall be entitled to the journey allowance, daily allowances and transportation of personal effects at the same scales and at the same rates as are applicable to a Group 'A' Officer of the Central Government drawing an equivalent pay.

(2) Foreign tours to be undertaken by the Chairman shall require prior approval of the State Government and as per the relevant rules of Central Government :

Provided that the daily allowance and provision for hotel accommodation during the period of tour abroad, shall be in accordance with such orders of the Central Government as are applicable to a Group- 'A' officer of the Central Government, drawing an equivalent pay and as per the economy instructions or other instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance from time to time.

10. **Leave travel concession :** The Chairman shall be entitled to leave travel concession at the same scale and at the same rate as applicable to Group 'A' officers of the Central Government drawing an equivalent pay :

Provided that if the Chairman has been a Judge of the Supreme Court or a Chief Justice of a High Court, he shall be entitled to leave travel concession at the same scale and at the same rate as applicable to a Judge of the Supreme Court or the Chief Justice of High Court, as the case may be same rate as applicable to a Judge of the Supreme Court or the Chief Justice of High Court, as the case may be.

11. **Accommodation :** The accommodation for the Chairman shall be provided by the State Government at par with the entitlement of Group 'A' officer of the Central Government drawing equivalent pay.

12. **Transport :** The Chairman shall be allowed the option to make use of an official vehicle or reimbursement of such amount as may be fixed from time to time in respect of a Group 'A' officer of the Central Government drawing an equivalent pay for the use and maintenance of his personal car.

13. **Medical treatment :** The Chairman shall be entitled to medical reimbursement and facility as may be applicable to a Group 'A' officer of the Central Government drawing an equivalent pay.

14. **Telephone facility, official meeting and entertainment expenses :** The Chairman shall be eligible for telephone facilities, official meeting and entertainment expenses as admissible to a Group 'A' officer of the Central Government drawing an equivalent pay.

15. **Other condition of services :** Other condition of service of the Chairman with respect to which no express provision has been made in these rules, shall be such as are applicable to a Group 'A' officer of the Central Government drawing an equivalent pay.

16. **Relaxation of provision of rules and certain cases :** When the State Government is satisfied that operation of any of these rules causes undue hardship in any particular case, it may in the public interest and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax the requirements of that rule.
