Governor of the National Capital Territory o Delhi, hereby makes the following rues governing the salary, allowances and other conditions of service of the Chairperson and Members of the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission, namely:-

Short title and commencement (a) These rules may be called the Delhi Electricity
Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of the wances and other Conditions of Service of the Chairperson and Members) Rules 200 miles

- (2) They shall come into force or the date of help publication in the official Gazette.
- 2. Definitions. In these rules, linless the context atherwise requires,
 - (a) "Act" means the Delhi Electricity Reform Act, 2000 (Delhi Act 2 of 2001); 4
 - words and expressions used herein and not defined but defined in the Act, shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Act.
- 3.Oath of office and secrecy.—The Chairperson and Members snau, percent of the office, subscribe an oath of office and secrecy before the Minister of Power of the secrecy before administered in the following forms:—

Provided that in case a person appointed as the Chairperson or a Member is in receipt of any pension, the pay of such person shall be reduced by the gross amount of pension drawn by him:

Provided further that the Chairperson or a Member shall be entitled to draw allowances on the original basic pay before such fixation of pay.

- 5. Dearness allowance and city compensatory allowance. The Chairperson and a Member shall receive dearness allowance, city compensatory allowance and other allowances at the rate admissible to a Group 'A' Officer of the Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- 6. Leave.—The Chairperson or a Member shall be entitled to thirty days earned leave for every year of service. The payment of leave salary during leave shall be governed under the provisions of rule 40 of the Central Civil Services ((Leave)) Rules, 1972. A person may be entitled to encastanent of fifty per cent of earned leave to his oredit at any time.
- 7. Leave sanctioning authority—initine case of the Chairperson, the Minister of Power of the Government and in the case of a Nember the Chairperson, shall be the leave sanctioning authority.
- 8. Provident Fund. The Charperson and is Member shall be governed by the provisions of the Contributory Provident Fund Rules, 1962 and no option to subscribe under the provisions of the General Provident Fund (Central Services) Rules, 1960 shall be available. Additional pension and gratuity shall not be admissible for service rendered in the Commission.
- 9. Traveling allowances. (1) The Chairperson and a Member while on tour within India or on transfer (including the journey undertaken by self and family to join the Commission or on the expiry of term with the Commission to proceed to his home town with family) shall be entitled to the journey allowance, daily allowance and transportation of personal effects at the same scales and at the same rates as are applicable to Croup! Telephone facility, official moetings and entertainment expenses. —The Chairperson and a Member shall be eligible for telephone facilities, official meetings and entertainment expenses as admissible to a Group 'A' officer of the Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- 15. Other conditions of service Other condition of services of the Chairperson and a Member, with respect to which no express provision has been made in these rules, shall be such as are admissible to a Group 'A officer of the Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- 16. Relaxation of provision of rules in certain cases. When the Government is satisfied that operation of any of these rules causes undue hardship in any particular case, it may in the public interest and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax the requirements of that rule.
