2. The post of Deputy Director (Admin) at PGIMER, Chandigarh Is a non Central Staffing Scheme post in the pay scale of Rs. 37,400-67,000 (PB-4) with Grade Pay of Rs. 8,700/- p.m. is to be filled up on deputation basis for a period of 4 years through the Central Government as per the Recruitment Rules. Deputy Director (Admin) PGIMER is concerned with the administrative matters of the Institute in consultation with the Director of the Institute. The post also involves having a very close interaction with policies and programmes of the Government.
