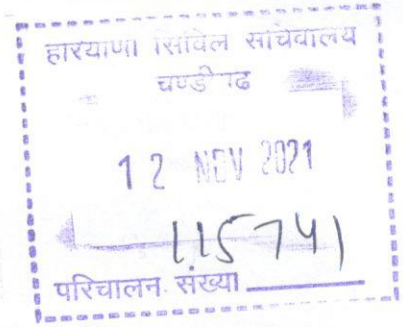

Subject: Selection for the post of Chairman, National Anti-Profitteering Authority-reg.

Sir/Madam,

Section 171 of the Central Goods and Services Act, 2017(Act) provides that the reduction in rate of tax on any supply of goods or services or the benefit of input tax credit shall be passed on by the supplier to the recipient (of such goods or services) by way of commensurate reduction in prices. Further, the Central Government may, on recommendation of the GST Council, constitute an Authority to examine whether the reduction in rate of tax or the benefit of input tax credit has actually resulted in a commensurate reduction in the prices of goods and services.

2. As per Rule 122 of the Central Goods and Services Tax Rules, 2017, the National Anti-Profitteering Authority (NAA) shall, apart from a Chairman, consist of four Technical Members who are or have been Commissioners of State Tax or Central Tax for at least one year or have held an equivalent post under the existing law, to be nominated by the GST Council.

3. As per Rule 122(a) of CGST Rules 2017, the officers who hold or have held a post equivalent in rank to a Secretary to the Government of India are eligible to be appointed as Chairman of the NAA.

4. Rule 124(4) of CGST Rules 2017, provides that the Chairman of the Authority shall hold office for a term of two years from the date on which he enters upon his office or until he attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier and shall be eligible for reappointment:-

Provided that person shall not be selected as the Chairman if he has attained the age of 62 years.

(Provided further that the Central Government with the approval of the Chairperson of the Council may terminate the appointment of the Chairman at any time)

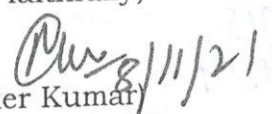
5. Further, Rule 137 of the CGST Rules 2017 provides that the Authority shall cease to exist after the expiry of two years from the date on which the Chairman enters upon his office unless the Council recommends otherwise. As per the recommendation of the GST Council, the tenure of the Authority has further been extended for a period of one year beyond 30.11.2021.

6. As per Rule 124(2) of CGST Rules 2017, the Chairman shall be paid a monthly salary of Rs.2,25,000 (fixed) and other allowances and benefits as are admissible to a Central Government officer holding posts carrying the same pay:

Provided that where a retired officer is selected as a Chairman, he shall be paid a monthly salary of Rs.2,25,000 reduced by the amount of pension.

7. It is requested to forward applications of eligible and willing officers in the proforma enclosed (Annexure-I) along with their cadre clearance/vigilance clearance and details of complaints, if any/Attested copies of APAR for the last 10 available years for appointment as Chairman, National Anti-Profiteering Authority (NAA) by **22.11.2021.**
