**Notification**

The 27th November, 2008

**No. G.S.R. 41/Const./Art. 309/2008.**— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Haryana hereby constitutes, with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette, "The Haryana Group 'D' Employees Selection Committee" to be constituted by the State Government. The constitution and functions of the Committee shall be as follows, namely:—

**1. Constitution of the Committee:—** The Committee shall consist of five members, including the Chairman. All members shall be officers not below the rank of Joint Secretary in the Government of Haryana. The Committee may act notwithstanding the absence or leave or otherwise of the Chairman or any other member.

**2. Functions:—**

- (i) All appointments to Group D posts under the Haryana Government, except appointments of officers and employees of the Punjab and Haryana High Court provided for in article 229 of the Constitution of India, shall be made on the recommendations of the Committee.
- (ii) All appointments to posts carrying an initial pay of less than three thousand and fifty rupees per mensem under State Public Undertakings, Boards, Corporations, Local Bodies such as Municipalities, Municipal Corporations, Town Improvement Trusts, Zila Parishads and Panchayat Samities or Co-operative institutions, as the case may be, shall be made on the recommendations of the Committee, keeping in view the rules and bye-laws governing them:

Provided that the order of merit as determined by the Committee shall not be disturbed by the appointing authority:

Provided further that the State Government shall be competent to exclude any such post from the purview of the Committee:

Provided further that the posts which have already been advertised by the respective competent authorities shall not be affected.

**3. The duration of the Committee shall be three years. The period can be reduced or extended by the State Government.**

4. **Leave:**— The Chairman and members of the Committee shall be entitled to leave, as per their entitlement.

5. **Travelling Allowance:**— The Chairman and members of the Committee shall be governed by the travelling allowance rules as applicable to them.

6. The State Government shall be competent to fix the headquarters and other places at which the Committee may function from time to time and make such other regulations as may be necessary for the due performance of the functions of the Committee.
